<u>Numeracy - Number</u> Can you find objects around the house and order them from smallest to biggest? <u>Extension</u> Do you have a ruler or tape measure? Can you measure the objects you have found? Can you take a picture and talk about the objects?		<u>Physical- Balancing</u> Can you balance on one leg? How long can you balance for? Time yourself and write down your results. <u>Extension</u> Can you balance on the opposite leg? Are the timings different?		<u>Understanding the World- My home</u> Draw a picture of someone dressed for a cold winter day. <u>Extension</u> Label the clothes they are wearing to keep them warm and dry.	
<u>Literacy-Writing</u> Emma the explorer has a list of things she needs but cannot read it. Can you help Emma work out what she needs to take? Sound out the words below to find out what she needs. M-a-p C-u-p H-a-t P-e-n <u>Extension</u> Draw a picture for each item and label what it is.		<u>PSED- likes and dislikes</u> We all have tastes that we like and dislike. Draw or write what tastes you like and dislike. Compare them with a friend. <u>Extension</u> Can you label your drawings?		<u>Literacy –Reading Rhythm and rhymes.</u> What rhymes or poems do you say at home? Find a copy of your favourite rhyme or poem to share with a friend. <u>Extension</u> Can you write down your favourite rhyme or poem?	
<u>Numeracy- Repeating patterns</u> Collect five pebbles, five sticks and five leaves from outside. Can you make a pattern that goes, pebble, stick, leaf, pebble? Can you complete it? <u>Extension</u> Paint/colour the pebbles different colours and make a pattern with them. How many more patterns can you make?		<u>EAD-Model Making</u> Some animals live in cold places around the world. Research which animals live in colder places. Draw or make a model of an animal that lives in a cold place. <u>Extension</u> Write a fact about the animal you have drawn or made.		<u>PD+MH-Exercise</u> Can you walk, jog and run from one point to another? Start with a walk then begin to jog. Finish on a run. <u>Extension</u> How many times can you walk, jog and run? Check your pulse. Can you feel your heart beating faster? Why is it beating so fast?	
				<u>Understanding the World</u> On a winter morning the ground often looks white with frost. Go on a walk and ask a grown up to help you investigate the frost and find out where it comes from. <u>Extension</u> Can you draw a picture of your findings or take some pictures on your walk.
