Home / School Agreement



The aim of Park View's Home/School Agreement is to foster an effective partnership between parents and carers, school and children. By working together we can support children's learning, helping them to achieve their full potential and enjoy their time at school.

Agreement for Parents and Carers

To help my child at school, I will:

- Make sure that my child arrives in school on time at 8.50am and is collected on time at 3.15pm
- Make sure that my child attends school regularly or contact school as soon as possible, if my child is absent for any reason
- Support school in maintaining good behaviour and discipline at all times
- Encourage my child to work hard and complete all homework tasks, including shared reading activities
- Attend parents' evenings to discuss my child's attainment, progress and achievements
- Ensure that my child wears the correct school uniform
- Let school know if there are any problems that may affect my child's ability to learn
- Use social media responsibly and positively as a vehicle to celebrate pupil and school achievements. I will discuss any concerns or issues directly and openly with school. Please note: any comments posted on social media that are prejudicial, derogatory or defamatory about any pupil, parent, member of staff or school may result in prosecution

Agreement for Children

To help me do well at school, I will:

- Follow the school rules and behave well at all times
- Work hard and listen carefully to instructions
- Attend school regularly and be on time
- Be polite and respectful to other children and to all adults
- Complete my homework on time
- Wear the school uniform at all times
- Take good care of school property and our school environment

Agreement for School

The school will:

- Encourage children to do their best at all times
- Provide a curriculum overview for each year group
- Contact parents and carers as soon as possible if school is concerned about children's work; behaviour; attendance or punctuality
- Welcome parents and carers into the life of our school and keep them informed about general school matters
- Keep parents and carers informed about how their child is progressing through: briefings; workshops; parents evenings and school reports
- Set children regular homework tasks including reading activities
- Offer a broad and balanced curriculum which meets the needs of all children
- Offer children enriching extra-curricular opportunities
