



Park View Primary School admission procedures.

Children that become age 4 between 1st September and 31st August will be eligible to start in reception class at primary school in the following September.

Applying for a place in a Bury school is now done online. Park View Primary School is bound by the admissions criteria set by Bury. Any children who live in a neighbouring authority must apply through their own authority's system. The neighbouring authority will then liaise with Bury. If you require help with the process, or do not have a computer at home, please contact our school and we will be happy to assist you. It would also help if you let our school know that you intend to apply. This will allow us to:

- Send Letters to parents on school list inviting them to any Open Days.
- Invite you to the Induction Meeting in the Summer Term for the parents of all new Reception children.
- After places are allocated, invite the children to visit our school.

Applying for school places

Children in Bury www.bury.gov.uk (search Education, applying online).

The online application form for school admissions is a quick, easy and secure way of applying for your child's place at primary or secondary school. You will get an email acknowledgement once your application is submitted. Applying online also means that you can access your school offer slightly earlier than the offer letter arriving, *if your child has their fourth birthday between 1 September and 31 August they may start school in the following September. All applications must be submitted between 30th October and the 15th January, offers of primary school places will be issued by second class post on during the following April.*
