Autumn Term Curriculum Plan

Literacy

Word Reading:

- Recognise their own name
- Develop their phonological awareness

Writing:

- Ascribe meaning to marks (signage).

Comprehension:

- Through discussion, talk about the book, including the characters and what might happen next

Understanding the World

- Explores how things work.
- Talk about the differences they have experienced or seen in photos.
- Using their senses to explore the world around them.

PE

- Use alternative feet to go up and down steps.
- Take part in group and team activities.

Maths

Number:

- Say one number for each item in order: 1, 2, 3, 4, 5.
- Show 'finger numbers' up to 5.
- Experiment with their own symbols and marks as well as numerals.

Numerical patterns:

- Talk about and identify the patterns around them.
- Describe a familiar route

Communication and Language

- Build good relationships with adults and peers.
- Engage in meaningful role-play, which reflects their experiences and interests.
- Be able to listen to and join in with a range of stories.
