## Spring Term Curriculum Plan

### Literacy

#### Word Reading:

- Spot and suggest rhymes
- Count or clap syllables in a word

#### Writing:

- Start to form identifiable shapes/letters.

#### Comprehension:

- Through discussion, talk about the book, including the characters and what might happen next

### Understanding the World

- Shows interest in different occupations.
- Plant seeds and care for growing plants
- Begin to respect and take care for the environment and living things.

### PE

- Shows a preference for a dominant hand.
- Beginning to become independent with dressing and undressing themselves.
- Collaborate with others to move objects and items safely.

### Maths

#### Number:

- Link numerals and amounts.
- Solve real world mathematical problems with numbers up to 5.
- Recite numbers past 5.

#### Numerical patterns:

- Extend and create ABAB patterns - stick, leaf, stick, leaf.
- Positional language

### Communication and Language

- Know when they need to ask for help and be confident to do so.
- Begin to understand and ask "how" and "why" questions.

### Expressive Arts and Design

- Understand the structure of stories.
- Develop their physical skills to manipulate tools and equipment with control and to begin to move with control

- Feel the beat in music and tap along.
