Write a letter of application to the UK Space Agency to become an astronaut.

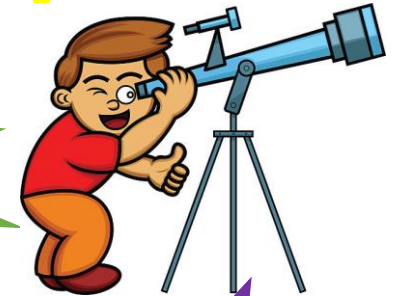


Imagine ... an alien space ship has crashed landed in your garden. Write your own story about what happens next.
